BALLOT QUESTION 4A

SHALL DURANGO FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT TAXES BE INCREASED \$1,476,881 ANNUALLY IN THE FIRST FULL YEAR (2017 TAXES PAYABLE IN 2018), FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FIRE PROTECTION AND EMERGENCY SERVICES, AND FOR OTHER EXPENSES OF THE DISTRICT WITHOUT LIMITATION; SUCH TAXES TO BE GENERATED FROM AN INCREASED LEVY OF 2.5 MILLS AND BY SUCH AMOUNTS AS MAY BE COLLECTED ANNUALLY THEREAFTER FROM A MILL LEVY NOT TO EXCEED 8.2 MILLS (THE EXISTING VOTER APPROVED 5.7 MILLS AND THE ADDITIONAL 2.5 MILLS), SUCH LEVY TO BE IMPOSED ONLY UPON THE APPROVAL OF A 2.5 MILL LEVY BY THE VOTERS IN THE CITY OF DURANGO FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING THE DISTRICT FOR FIRE PROTECTION AND EMERGENCY SERVICES WITHIN THE CITY; AND SHALL THE DISTRICT BE AUTHORIZED TO COLLECT, RETAIN AND SPEND THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH TAXES AND ALL OTHER AMOUNTS RECEIVED ANNUALLY FROM ANY REVENUE SOURCES WHATSOEVER AS A VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE WITHOUT REGARD TO ANY SPENDING, REVENUE-RAISING OR OTHER LIMITATION CONTAINED WITHIN ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION, SECTION 29-1-301, C.R.S., OR ANY OTHER LAW?

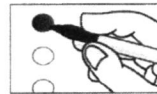

BALLOT QUESTION 2A

AUTHORIZATION TO INCREASE CITY PROPERTY TAXES 2.5 MILLS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING FOR FIRE PROTECTION AND EMERGENCY SERVICES PROVIDED WITHIN THE CITY BY THE DURANGO FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT AND TO AMEND THE AGREEMENT WITH THE DISTRICT TO INCREASE THE ANNUAL FEE PAYABLE BY THE CITY TO THE DISTRICT.

SHALL CITY OF DURANGO TAXES BE INCREASED NOT MORE THAN \$1,500,000 IN TAX COLLECTION YEAR 2018 AND BY WHATEVER AMOUNTS ARE GENERATED ANNUALLY THEREAFTER BY A MILL LEVY OF NOT MORE THAN 2.5 MILLS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING FOR FIRE PROTECTION AND EMERGENCY SERVICES PROVIDED WITHIN THE CITY BY THE DURANGO FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT AND SHALL THE CITY BE AUTHORIZED TO AMEND THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND THE DISTRICT WHICH WAS APPROVED BY CITY VOTERS ON NOVEMBER 5, 2013, TO INCREASE THE ANNUAL FEE PAYABLE TO THE DISTRICT BY THE AMOUNT GENERATED BY THE 2.5 MILL LEVY AND TO AMEND THE TERM OF THE AGREEMENT TO THE EXTENT THE COUNCIL DETERMINES IT IS NECESSARY TO DO SO TO COMPLY WITH THE CITY CHARTER; PROVIDED THAT THIS AUTHORIZATION SHALL BE CONTINGENT UPON THE VOTERS OF THE DISTRICT APPROVING A DISTRICT MILL LEVY INCREASE OF 2.5 MILLS AT THE NOVEMBER 7, 2017 ELECTION?

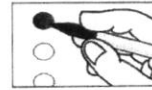
